The St Ives Golf Club provides members with the opportunity of being part of a genuine quality golf experience. Costing £9,000,000 the course, practice facilities and clubhouse have been designed to the highest standards to meet the needs of a 21st Century.

- **THE COURSE** – Architect designed on 230 acres of farmland, this unique inland links course provides a testing but fair challenge to the keen golfer. Greens have been built to the highest USGA standards and are the first in the country to be sown throughout with Velvet Bent grass that ensures the finest putting surfaces in the region. All fairways have been capped with sand to give that links feel under the club. Greens, fairways and even bunkers are fully drained to provide the best playing conditions throughout the year. In the event of dry weather all greens and fairways have irrigation.
- **THE GOLFING EXPERIENCE** – Regular competitions are held for members throughout the year for all handicap levels. Such competitions also include those specific to Ladies, Seniors, Juniors as well as the wider membership.
- **PRACTICE FACILITIES** – A purpose built floodlit driving range is open to members and guests to improve their game or to warm up before that important match from mat or grass tees.
